The aircraft were sold very cheaply and Doug was able to resell the planes at a very handsome profit. Sea Fury T. Mk. 20S was photographed on the ramp at Blackbushe (Doug's airfield), England, during August 1974 and the British registration G-BCKG had replaced the German D-CAFO. The plane was quickly sold to Steve Schulke as N62143 and in an epic mission it flew the Atlantic to in Florida. It went through several owners and was destroyed in a hangar fire at Minter Field, Shafter, California, during July 1988.
